- The board approved up to \$8,280.65 for kitchen equipment for the concession stand(s) at Lake Stephens.
- The board will go over the Emergency Call Box for Marsh Fork during the June meeting.
- The Girl Scout Troop cleaned up the trash around Dry Hill and has posted a sign to encourage others to pick up their trash.
- The walking cooler for the 4-H Camp will be installed soon.
- The 4-H Camp will be hosting a BBQ Dinner fundraiser on June 1st. Tickets will need to be bought in advance.
- 4-H Camps are schedule for June 9-13 and June 10-14.
- WE are still getting estimates on the roof repair at 4-H.
- The Splash Pad and Beach at Lake Stephens will open on Saturday May 25th.
- The Splash Pad has been completely sandblasted.
- The new restrooms at Lake Stephens are almost completed. The new benches and lockers will be in any day now.
- Lake Stephens' Annual Beach Blast will be May 31st and June 1st.
- Lake Stephens will be having special events/holiday weekends in the Campground for campers.
- Lake Stephens is still getting quotes for fires which will most likely be held on July 5th.
- Marina 2 is on hold for now.
- DEP and Alliance will be getting us an updated plan on the work and cost of the repairs required for the dam.

- We are still discussing the future of Disc Golf at Lake Stephens.
